

GUIDELINES FOR THE GREENVILLE COUNCIL PTA 2016 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Three scholarships will be awarded to help finance higher education plans for graduating students.

The scholarship will be for current graduates of the Greenville School district.

Applicants must be a member of PTSA or have a family member as a member of a Greenville PTA.

The award is based on character, initiative to pursue a degree, scholastic ability, financial need, and family involvement in PTA and/or PTSA.

The scholarship can be used at any accredited college or technical school.

The recipient shall inform the council president of his or her progress once each semester.

The recipient shall agree to diligently pursue their higher education degree until graduation requirements are fulfilled.

The scholarship will have a cash value of \$1000.00. The method of payment will be:

- 1) The first half of the cash value will be awarded after proof of registration for the fall semester of college is submitted.
- 2) The second half of the cash value will be awarded after proof of registration for the spring semester and fall grades are submitted. If placed on academic probation by the university, no further payment will be made.

Students must carry a minimum of 12 hours a semester and maintain a 2.5 grade average.

Applicants must file applications with the counselor at the High School by **April 1, 2016** for consideration of these awards.

The announcement/presentation of the scholarship recipients will occur at the May 10, 2016 Council PTA Association meeting, noon, at the Wesley Martin Board Room.
