Jewel Elizabeth Moseley Rowe, prior to her death in 2007, was a life-long member of First Presbyterian Church of Greenville, Texas. She began teaching at Greenville High School in 1957 and retired in 1984. Most of her teaching career was spent in teaching Junior English. She was dedicated as a servant to the church and to furthering education by serving on the Multisensory Learning Center Board for 20 years.

QUALIFICATIONS

Students applying for the above scholarship must be graduating seniors of a public or private high school in Greenville who will enter a 2 or 4 year college program upon completion of their high school diploma.

Students shall be active participating members of an area church.

Students entering college shall have maintained an overall 80 academic average during their high school years.

Scholarship assistance offered for the first year of post-high school training shall be in two separate installments, the second is dependent upon the student's progress as follows:

- An academic average of 2.5 shall be maintained on a 4.0 scale during the first semester to qualify for the remainder of funds during the first year.
- Enrollment of the student shall be "full-time" as determined by the full-time
 enrollment policy of the particular school. This applies to both semesters
 for which the student shall receive funds.

NON-RENEWABLE PROVISION

There is no provision for renewal of scholarship assistance. Funds are available on a one-time basis to the student engaged in the first year of post-high school preparation.

AMOUNT AND PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Amounts of stipend assistance will vary from year to year as funds are available. One stipend in the amount of \$1000 is to be awarded (\$500 per semester) for 2016.

Upon proof of registration for the fall semester classes, the first check will be issued to the college in the name of the student. Likewise, upon proof of registration for the spring semester classes and presentation of first semester grades to verify the 2.5 GPA, the final amount of the scholarship will be awarded.

RECOMMENDATIONS

As part of the application procedure, students shall arrange for two personal recommendations from the following to be mailed directly to United Presbyterian Church:

- 1. Pastor or governing board chairman of the applicant's church.
- 2. A teacher or other faculty member at the applicant's school.

It is the applicants' responsibility to insure that these letters have been mailed by **Wednesday, March 23, 2016**. The applicant is also responsible for making sure all the checklist items are complete when turning in the forms. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS

Each spring, notice shall be made through the applicant's high school counselor's office concerning the availability of funds through the JEWEL ROWE SCHOLARSHIP FUND. Pastors and appropriate lay-persons are encouraged to make this information known to their membership. Selection of recipients shall be made by a special Scholarship Committee, named for this purpose by the governing board of United Presbyterian Church, based upon such factors as financial need, scholarship, churchmanship, citizenship, extra-curricular activities, etc. In addition, applicants may be requested to appear before the Selection Committee for personal interview.

APPLICATION FORMS

Application forms are available through the Counselor's Office at the public and private Greenville high schools.

Forms and accompanying information requested shall be postmarked no later than March 23, 2016, so that selection may be made prior to high school graduation.

All interested, qualifying seniors of public and private Greenville high schools are encouraged to apply.
