The following establishes the terms and conditions for students to transfer to Greenville ISD for the 2019-2020 school year:

- A. This is effective for the 2019-2020 year only. District approval of this transfer creates no right or expectation that the student will be admitted as a transfer for any subsequent school year.
Transfer dependent upon availability of space.
- B. Transfers are approved on a student-by student basis. District approval of a transfer for one student creates no right or expectation that another student from the same family will be admitted as a transfer.
- C. Student must maintain acceptable levels of attendance, academic achievement, and compliance with the Student Code of Conduct throughout the entire schools year. Acceptable levels are defined as:
 1. Attendance that does not place the student at risk of losing credit under Texas Education Code 25.092 or require the district to warn the parent or the student of truancy proceedings under Education Code 25.095;
 2. Academic achievement that results in a passing grade in all courses by the end of the school year;
 3. Compliance will the Student Code of Conduct that results in no offenses requiring removal to a Discipline Alternative Education Program or expulsion.
- D. Transportation will not be provided for student that transfer.
