Any such arbitration shall be conducted by a single arbitrator, who shall have authority to award actual damages, attorney's fees, and costs of arbitration to the prevailing party, but shall have no authority to award any penalties or any exemplary, consequential, or punitive damages to any party.

- Your rights will be determined by a neutral arbitrator and not by a judge or jury.
