## STAAR Redesign in 2023

- Online Testing \& Accommodations
- Assessment administered in online platform and allows eligible students to receive accommodations to address their specific learning needs
- New Question Types
- Includes the addition of new, non-multiple choice questions
- Cross-Curricular Passages
- Increased the number of cross-curricular informational passages on the RLA assessments that reference content aligned to the TEKS in other subject areas
- Evidence-Based Writing
- Extended Constructed Responses, or essays responding to text, are required on all RLA assessments at every grade level
- Short constructed response questions are also options on RLA, Science and Social Studies assessments.

## STAAR Alternate 2

- Alternate standardized item-based assessment administered individually to eligible students with the most significant cognitive disabilities who are receiving special education services.
- A paper assessment in mathematics, reading language arts (RLA), science, and social studies for students in grades 3-8 and high school.
- A student's admission, review, and dismissal (ARD) committee must determine if the student meets the participation requirements for STAAR Alternate 2.

## TELPAS

- English language proficiency assessment designed to assess the progress that emergent bilingual (EB) students make in learning the English language.
- Kindergarten through grade 12 are assessed in four domains - listening, speaking, reading and writing.
- Grades 2 through 12 complete online testing.
- Composite proficiency ratings provide a single overall level of English language proficiency derived from the proficiency ratings in the four language domains.
