- Part 1: Complete and sign the application. Please use black ink
- Part 2: In a narrative form, describe your interests (3 pages typed or written). Tell us about your achievements and awards.
- Part 3: Attach a 500 word essay (typed or written on either of the 2 topics listed) "What are your goals and aspirations in life?" OR "What this scholarship opportunity means to me".
- Part 4: Attach a copy of your official high school transcript.
- **Part 5:** Attach a letter describing the following: (1) Which college you plan to attend, (2) total cost of education for that institution, (3) other financial aid for which you have applied or know you will receive, (4) anything else pertinent to your family's financial situation.
- Part 6: Three letters of recommendation written and signed (See details under References on page 5). Each letter must include your name and the name of person writing the letter with their phone number in the upper right hand corner. Letters of recommendation must be signed and included in application packet in a sealed envelope with Signature across the seal.
