Frequently Asked Questions 2024-2025

1.) What grades will be served at Travis Intermediate for the 2024-2025 school year?

Travis Intermediate will serve all fifth and sixth grade students in Greenville ISD for the upcoming school year.

2.) Is Gifted and Talented offered at Travis Intermediate? How is it structured?

The Gifted and Talented program at Travis Intermediate offers students a variety of project-based ways to be challenged throughout the school year. Students are served during Intervention time for a total of two hours per week. Students are required to be enrolled in Honors classes for the Gifted & Talented program.

3.) Will Travis offer a Dual Language program?

The Dual Language program will be offered at Travis Intermediate next school year. Fourth grade students from both Bowie and Carver elementary schools who were enrolled in the dual language program will finish their last year in fifth grade.

4.) My child is enrolled in special programs. Will they continue to be served?

Yes, Travis intermediate offers a continuum of services for special education. The campus will implement your child's current plan if he or she is serviced through 504 or special education.

5.) How many teachers will my child have?

Three core subject teachers (Math, Reading, Science/Social Studies) and two extra-curricular teachers (Art/Music). Our music teacher will be on campus the first semester and the art teacher will hold classes the second semester.

6.) Where and how do I register my child for school?

Greenville ISD will open registration for the 2024-25 school year on July 15, 2024. This process is online through your Skyward Parent Access. Please visit https://www.greenvilleisd.com/Page/2423 if you have additional questions.

7.) What supplies will I need to buy?

The school supply list will be posted on the Travis Intermediate website at https://www.greenvilleisd.com/Page/2536. The updated school supply list will also be shared with all parents when available through the school messaging system.

8.) How do I find out about bus stops and schedules?

You can look up your child's bus stop information on the <u>GISD Transportation Department website</u>. Type an address and enter your child's grade to see the school zone for that address. Regular education bus routes with stops and times will be displayed. Special programs including Dual Language, KGJ STEM Academy, New Horizons, and ACE are available by calling the Transportation Department at 903-457-8658.



9.) Will my child need any special clothing for P.E.?

Students can wear their normal clothing during P.E. Athletic type shoes are needed to participate in the gym activities.

11.) Where should I drop off and pick up my child daily?

All 5th grade students can be dropped off and picked up on the 5th grade side of the building (off King Street.) However if you have a 6th grade student and a 5th grade student both can be dropped off or picked up at either entrance. If a student is late, please drop them off at the front door so that they can receive a tardy pass. You do not have to enter the building.

12.) Will my child be allowed to have their cell phone at school?

According to the student code of conduct, all students are allowed to have cell phones at school. Students are allowed to use their cell phones ONLY during passing periods and at lunch. However, there will be specific times that cell phones will not be allowed out at all such as during State Testing. Also all teachers are required to pick up phones daily at the beginning of each class period. Phones are returned at the end of each class. You can see a copy of the GISD Cell Phone Policy HERE.

13.) Will there be any after school child care provided?
