

Greenville ECHS Admissions Policy

Greenville Early College High School's primary focus is providing students from underrepresented backgrounds the opportunity to earn up to 60 college hours free of charge while attending high school. As a Texas Education Agency designated PTECH/ICIA campus, we must target students from underrepresented backgrounds; however, we encourage students of all backgrounds to apply.

Early College High School is available to any GMS 8th grade student that meets the criteria listed below:

1. The student must have a desire to be a part of the ECHS program and explain this in writing during the application process.
2. The student's parent and/or guardian must want their child to be part of the program.
3. Both the parent/guardian and the student must agree to abide by the standards of academic and behavioral expectations of ECHS.
4. Both the parent/guardian and the student must agree to comply with all of the policies of the program including the Electronic Student Acknowledgement Agreement for issued electronic devices.
5. Both parent/guardian and student must agree that the ultimate goal is to graduate from Greenville ECHS with college credits as individually planned.

Note: In accordance with the Texas Education Agency rules for PTECH/ICIA Blueprint Benchmark 2, academics, discipline, state assessments, disabilities, LEP status, grade point average, and/or teacher recommendations cannot be considered in the selection process.
