

School Fire Lane Warning

The City of Greenville has an ordinance for parking in fire lanes within the city limits. The ordinance is:

Title I General Ordinances: Chapter 8 Fire Prevention and Protection Section 8.06.008 Stopping, Standing or Parking vehicle in Fire Lane.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to park or leave standing any non-emergency vehicle, whether attended or unattended, in a designated fire lane.
- (b) When schools are in session, a person may temporarily stop no more than 20 minutes before and after the designated start time of school in a fire lane located within a school zone and stop no more than 20 minutes before and after the designated end time of school within a school zone in a fire lane as long as the vehicle is continuously attended by the operator of the vehicle.
- (c) All emergency personnel have first priority in designated fire lanes and stopped vehicles will have to be moved immediately upon notification or arrival of emergency vehicles and/or personnel.

(Ordinance 15-068 adopted 12/8/15)

This is a municipal fine of \$105.00 and will be settled with the city's municipal judge.
